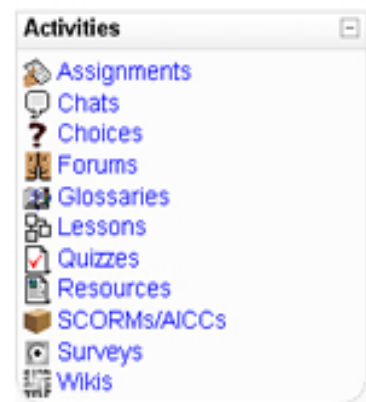

What is Moodle?

Moodle is a free software e-learning platform (also known as a Course Management System (CMS)), Moodle is designed to help educators create online courses with opportunities for rich interaction. Its open source license and modular design means that people can develop additional functionality.

- Instructors can design lessons with a great deal of flexibility, from scheduling to forums.
- Moodle is all about social education - students are encouraged to develop an identity within Moodle and interact with other students
- Moodle can operate online distance-learning classes or supplement classroom instruction time
- Instructors can easily embed multimedia in activities and link to other web resource
- Students can easily complete tasks and assignments (on-line text, uploading . . .)



Moodle lessons can include discussion forums, group assignment areas, and announcement boards.

Learners create a personal profile that can include a picture, helping connect students socially in the online learning community.
